

# NAMING Opportunities

## OUTDOOR AREAS

### 1. The Green

**\$1,000,000**

"The Green" will be a beautifully manicured space suitable for outdoor concerts, festivals and special events. The space itself is a destination.

### 2. Automated Book Drops (2)

**\$50,000 each for 5 years**

Automated book drops will allow easy return of books on the west side of the building and from your vehicle on the east side of the building. This underwriting is limited to five years due to changing technology and advertising possibilities.

### 4-6. Restoration of Decorative Stonework

The exterior stonework on the front/top of the AHS building is one of the most distinctive and defining elements of the 1920s architecture. Cleaning and restoration are important for the overall appearance and renovation of this important building in Abilene's history.

Restoration of grotesques (2 statues) on roof

## HISTORIC ACADEMIC BUILDING

### 10. Interactive Wayfinding Kiosks

**\$35,000 each or \$220,000 for all seven kiosks**

Digital kiosks will be placed on each floor near the elevators (3), and at the main entrances to AHS (2), in the area near the historic auditorium (1) and in the Grace Museum space (1). The kiosks will present interactive wayfinding maps for the center, promote AHS and library events and be used to give ongoing donor recognition. This underwriting is limited to five years due to changing technology and advertising possibilities.

### 11. Library Assistant Director's Office

**\$10,000**

Space for the Assistant Director's office.

### 12. Library Business Office

**\$10,000**

Space to create a welcoming environment for library staff business.

### 13-15. Library Offices A – C

**\$5,000 each**

Space to create a welcoming environment for library staff.

\$5,000**

Space to make this office a functional and attractive workspace for library staff.

**18. Library Youth Services Office/2<sup>nd</sup> Floor  
\$10,000**

Space for the library's Youth Services staff.

**20. Historic Chalkboards (2)  
\$10,000 each**

Antique chalkboards that were found during the demolition process will be restored and used as decorative walls. One chalkboard is in the public area on the first floor and the second one is in the library staff area on the second floor.

## **LIBRARY NEW CONSTRUCTION (FIRST FLOOR)**

**21. Adult Fiction Area  
\$200,000**

Stories can take the reader to far off places and times, and this area houses the library's collection of adult fiction.

## **LIBRARY NEW CONSTRUCTION (SECOND FLOOR)**

**25. Tot Area  
\$350,000**

A vibrant space where toddlers and parents can engage with learning and each other.

**27. Youth Services Work Area  
\$7,500**

A functional and attractive workspace for library staff.

## **LIBRARY NEW CONSTRUCTION (THIRD FLOOR)**

**29-32. Small Group Study Room A – D (4 rooms)  
\$15,000 each**

A quiet place for you to study or meet in a small group.

**33. Computer Hub  
\$45,000**

A place where you can learn computer tools and techniques with others or use a public computer when no organized activities are scheduled.

**34. Adult Nonfiction Area  
\$150,000**

Knowledge is power, and this area houses the library's collection of nonfiction and reference materials.

**35. Adult Services Staff Work Area  
\$5,000**

Space for a functional and attractive workspace for library staff.

**36. Adult Staff Services Work Area  
\$7,500**

Space for a functional and attractive workspace for library staff.

**37. Adult Services Reading Area  
\$35,000**

A pleasant area for reading and relaxing overlooking The Green.

## SPECIAL EVENTS/EAGLES NEST

### 42. Eagles Nest Event Center \$1,000,000

The historic gym captures the memories of yesterday. As an event center it will include multimedia technology and table seating for up to 400 guests. This will be an exciting destination for many future events in Abilene.

### 43. Catering Kitchen \$50,000

The fully-outfitted catering kitchen accommodates events of any size across the entire AHS campus. With multiple entry points and thoughtfully designed spaces, this kitchen makes this venue appealing to caterers as well as renters.

## AUDITORIUM

### 45. Dressing Room/Multiuse Room \$10,000

An amply-sized dressing room offers comfortable and flexible prep area for performers from preschool to professional. With adjacent restrooms and convenient back-stage access, this room is ideal for any performer, group, or bridal party utilizing the historic auditorium.

### 46. Elevator Lobby and Cistern Display \$35,000

This exhibit demonstrates the significance of the 1890 water cistern that was discovered during the renovation of the building to become Abilene Heritage Square.
