## OUTDOOR AREAS

### 124. Northside Alcove \$100,000

The Northside outdoor entry includes the arched alcove and front steps where students made thousands of memories as they entered the school. It will now be utilized as one point of entry for the auditorium.

### 4-6. Restoration of Decorative Stonework

The exterior stonework on the front/top of the AHS building is one of the most distinctive and defining elements of the 1920s architecture. Cleaning and restoration are important for the overall appearance and renovation of this important building in Abilene's history.

### 10. Interactive Wayfinding Screens \$35,000 each or \$150,000 for the remaining five screens

Locations include:

- West Side Entry Foyer
- 1<sup>st</sup> Floor Library near elevator
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor Library near elevator
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor Library near elevator
- Eagles Nest Event Center

The screens will present interactive wayfinding maps for the center, promote AHS and library events, and be used to give ongoing donor recognition.

### 11. Library Assistant Director's Office \$10,000

Space for the Assistant Director's office.

### 12. Library Business Office \$10,000

Space to create a welcoming environment for library staff business.

### 13-15. Library Offices A – C \$5,000 each

Space to create a welcoming environment for library staff.

**21. Adult Fiction Area  
\$200,000**

Stories can take the reader to far-off places and times, and this area houses the library's collection of adult fiction.

**424. WOW Video Wall  
\$150,000**

A unique transparent video wall that separates the teen area from the remainder of the library's first-floor lobby. The wall will be programmed and customized for dynamic content, videos, animation, and live information updates.

**25. Tot Area  
\$350,000**

A vibrant space where toddlers and parents can engage with learning and each other.

**Family Reading Area  
\$ 25,000**

A welcoming and comfortable space designed to encourage reading and bonding among family members of all ages. Equipped with cozy seating, tables, and ample lighting.

**D 305-309 Small Group Study Room (5 rooms)

Quiet places to study of various sizes, to meet in small groups (4-6 people) on the third floor overlooking the west side entry plaza.

\$150,000**

### 42. Eagles Nest Event Center

**\$1,000,000**

**\$50,000**

The fully-outfitted catering kitchen accommodates events of any size across the entire AHS campus. With multiple entry points and thoughtfully designed spaces, this kitchen makes this venue appealing to caterers as well as renters.

### 524. Stairwell

**\$35,000**

This is the Interior historic staircase and stairwell serving the Stone Owl Institute and the east wing of the historic academic building.
